Other advanced topics include understanding and controlling circularity errors, troubleshooting, sensitivity/scenario analysis and discounted cash flow valuations.

The seminar is computer-based; a laptop with Microsoft Excel is required. We welcome both Mac and PC users. However, the seminar is optimized for Windows users. For the best experience, a PC is strongly encouraged. Mac users (including those running Windows) will need to change certain settings to optimize their Mac for the seminar.

Pre-requisites

Participants typically should have taken or be currently enrolled in an introductory-level accounting or corporate finance course. In addition, a basic understanding of Excel is essential to the overall learning experience.
