#### **Intensive Format**

1.5 credits = 1 week (4-6 days) 18 academic contact hours
3 credits = 2 weeks (10-13 days) 36 academic contact

## Am I Eligible?

- Good academic standing
- •Full-Time: Completed or are completing Stern Core (excluding Professional Responsibility) in semester of DBi
- •Langone: Eligible in the same semester in which you are registered for your 15<sup>th</sup> credit, as long as it is not your first semester at NYU Stern

## **Credits**

- Six credits of DBi apply to degree
- •Up to six credits of DBi may count toward Global Business specialization
- January and May DBis: Credits do not apply to semester maximum
- •Spring Break DBis: Credits do apply to semester maximum



# COVID-19 Disruption Precautions

#### **COVID-19 Precautions**





After lottery, please hold off on purchasing flights until notified.

You will have until **August 3rd 2021** to drop a Fall 2021 DBi with 100% tuition and program fee refund.

If NYU Stern cancels the DBi's at any point, the DBi Program Fee (along with tuition for the DBi, if applicable) will be refunded.

Verify your passport is valid for at least six months beyond January 2022 travel. The US Passport agency is experiencing **3-4 month delays** for passport renewals.



Since January DBi's do not count towards your Fall semester credit maximum, we encourage you to lottery for a **full course load in addition** to a DBi.

We recognize that you may be counting on receiving these DBi credits to graduate on time or are concerned about other implications should this course be canceled in the coming months.

Contact Academic Affairs & Advising department soon to discuss **alternative semester scheduling questions**.

More information about COVID-19 precautions and requirements will be shared as they are received or announced.
