Approximate expenses per month in Euro

- **Our Campus Dormitory:** Between 250-300 Euros

 - **Apartments:** shared flat between 500-750 Euros (for an apartment including electricity and water) - 10 min walking distance
 - **Food:** 250-350 Euro

Visa

Depending on your home country, you could need a visa or not. You can find here the list of countries which are exempt from visa to enter in Morocco: <https://www.esca.ma/en/international-relations/partners/>

If your country is not on this list, then you should apply for a visa from the Moroccan consulate in your country and present these documents:

- **Application form duly filled**
- **Valid passport**
- **3 identity photos**
- **Acceptance letter delivered by ESCA Ecole de Management**

The period of stay in Morocco for foreigners who are exempted from visa is limited to **3 months**.

You must request for an authorization from the General Office of National Security with the same documents as above in addition to:

- **The rental agreement which must be in your name.**
- **A copy of the entry stamp in Moroccan territory**

If the incoming student leaves the territory of Morocco during the 3 months and comes back, his stay will be systematically extended for other 3 months.

Insurance

International Insurance is Mandatory for all exchange students.
